1. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

(i) Only Indian Nationals should apply.

(ii) Relaxation in upper age limit:-

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer), and PWD & Ex-Servicemen as per Govt. of India rules.
- (b) Reservation of vacancies in respect of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes including minority (non-creamy layer), Ex-Servicemen, Persons With Disabilities (degree of disability 40% or above) as per Govt. of India guidelines.

- (c) The OBC Candidates who belong to "Creamy Layer" are not entitled for concession admissible to OBC category and such candidates have to indicate their category as General/UR. The OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates are required to submit requisite certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India and from a Competent Authority issued within six months from the date of publication of advertisement in employment news. Further, OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates will have to give a self-undertaking indication that they belong to OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) category at the time of joining, if selected.

3. SELECTION PROCESS:

(i) Location of Written Examination: Chennai, Delhi/NCR, Guwahati, Kolkata & Mumbai

- (ii) The candidate will be allowed to choose 1 (One) written examination center, out of the above mentioned 5 cities.
- (iii) There will be objective type written test with **120 questions** with total time: **120** minutes.
- (iv) The examination paper will contain total 120 objective type questions containing 80 questions related to post / discipline for which the candidate has applied, 10 questions on General Knowledge, 10 questions on General Intelligence/reasoning, 10 questions on Numerical Ability and 10 questions on English language.
- (v) There will be no negative marking.
- (vi) Test Paper will be bilingual: Hindi & English.
- (vii) <u>Disclaimer</u>: The required educational qualification should be from regular college and not through correspondence. Correspondence course will not be considered valid. Education imparted through distance education mode will not be considered valid.
- (viii) Syllabus for the exam is based on Staff Selection Commission (SSC) and detailed in Annexure-I.
- (ix) Only 1 (One) written examination city will be allowed to the candidate. Once submitted can not be altered.
- (x) Company will shortlist candidate for admission to written test.
- (x) Final selection will be through written test.
- xi) In case of tie of marks obtained by more than one Candidates, the resolution will be done in following order
 - a) The candidate with earlier/older Date of birth, will be placed higher i.e. the candidate in age seniority will be placed higher
 - b) In case of tie as mentioned at (a) above, the candidate with higher percentage pass marks in qualifying examination, as per eligibility criteria, will be placed higher.

The facility for conducting written examination for Persons with Disabilities will be provided in accordance to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs Letter No. F. No.16-110/2003-DD/III dated 26th February, 2013.

Empanelment of Candidates:

The final empanelment would be done on the basis of total marks secured (written score) by the candidate.

The offer of appointment shall be issued to the empanelled candidates in the order of category wise merit and based on requirement of the company.

HOW TO APPLY :

Candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions have to apply through online registration system of NPCC i.e. <u>http://www.npcc.gov.in</u>. Please go carefully through instructions under 'HOW TO APPLY' in this advertisement and also detailed instructions given on the main page of online filling up of application.

No application through other mode will be accepted. No documents are required to be sent to NPCC in connection with the application.

Online submission of the applications will be allowed on the website. Boundary wall, Brick building, Water Tank, Septic tank, Bar bending schedule, Centre line method, Mid-section formula, Trapezodial formula, Simpson's rule. Cost estimate of Septic tank, flexible pavements, Tube well, isolated and combined footings, Steel Truss, Piles and pile-caps. Valuation Value and cost, scrap value, salvage value, assessed value, sinking fund, depreciation and obsolescence, methods of valuation.
- **iii) Surveying** : Principles of surveying, measurement of distance, chain surveying, working of prismatic compass, compass traversing, bearings, local attraction, plane table surveying, theodolite traversing, adjustment of theodolite, Levelling, Definition of terms used in levelling, contouring, curvature and refraction corrections, temporary and permanent adjustments of dumpy level, methods of contouring, uses of contour map, tachometric survey, curve setting, earth work calculation, advanced surveying equipment.
- iv) Soil Mechanics : Origin of soil, phase diagram, Definitions-void ratio, porosity, degree of saturation, water content, specific gravity of soil grains, unit weights, density index and interrelationship of different parameters, Grain size distribution curves and their uses. Index properties of soils, Atterberg's limits, ISI soil classification and plasticity chart. Permeability of soil, coefficient of permeability, determination of coefficient of permeability, Unconfined and confined aquifers, effective stress, quick sand, consolidation of soils, Principles of consolidation, degree of consolidation, pre-consolidation pressure, normally consolidated soil, e-log p curve, computation of ultimate settlement. Shear strength of soils, direct shear test, Vane shear test, Triaxial test. Soil compaction, Laboratory compaction test, Maximum dry density and optimum moisture content, earth pressure theories, active and passive earth pressures, Bearing capacity of soils, plate load test, standard penetration test.
- v) Hydraulics: Fluid properties, hydrostatics, measurements of flow, Bernoulli's theorem and its application, flow through pipes, flow in open channels, weirs, flumes, spillways, pumps and turbines.
- vi) Irrigation Engineering : Definition, necessity, benefits, effects of irrigation, types and methods of irrigation, Hydrology – Measurement of rainfall, run off coefficient, rain gauge, losses from precipitation – evaporation, infiltration, etc. Water requirement of crops, duty, delta and base period, Kharif and Rabi Crops, Command area, Time factor, Crop ratio, Overlap allowance, Irrigation efficiencies. Different type of canals, types of canal irrigation, loss of water in canals. Canal lining – types and advantages. Shallow and deep to wells, yield from a well. Weir and barrage, Failure of

weirs and permeable foundation, Slit and Scour, Kennedy's theory of critical velocity. Lacey's theory of uniform flow. Definition of flood, causes and effects, methods of flood control, water logging, preventive measures. Land reclamation, Characteristics of affecting fertility of soils, purposes, methods, description of land and reclamation processes. Major irrigation projects in India.

- vii) Transportation Engineering : Highway Engineering cross sectional elements, geometric design, types of pavements, pavement materials aggregates and bitumen, different tests, Design of flexible and rigid pavements Water Bound Macadam (WBM) and Wet Mix Macadam (WMM), Gravel Road, Bituminous construction, Rigid pavement joint, pavement maintenance, Highway drainage, Railway Engineering- Components of permanent way sleepers, ballast, fixtures and fastening, track geometry, points and crossings, track junction, stations and yards. Traffic Engineering Different traffic survey, speed-flow-density and their interrelationships, intersections and interchanges, traffic signals, traffic operation, traffic signs and markings, road safety.
- viii) Environmental Engineering : Quality of water, source of water supply, purification of water, distribution of water, need of sanitation, sewerage systems, circular sewer, oval sewer, sewer appurtenances, sewage treatments. Surface water drainage. Solid waste management types, effects, engineered management system. Air pollution pollutants, causes, effects, control. Noise pollution cause, health effects, control.
