MESSAGE FROM Chairman & Managing Director

Dear Readers,

It is with immense satisfaction that I present this month's milestones from NPCC's journey of nation-building. Guided by the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, we remain committed to accelerating infrastructure delivery, educational growth, healthcare excellence, and administrative strengthening across India.

In West Bengal, under the aegis of the Tarakeswar Development Authority, NPCC is executing the Storm Water Drainage Scheme for Tarakeswar, Hooghly, involving five pumping stations, pipe-laying, and an integrated drainage network. In Arunachal Pradesh, the Kendriya Vidyalaya at Longding has been completed with academic blocks, housing, and sports facilities, while Kendriya Vidyalaya, Sandhole, Himachal Pradesh, is now fully operational.

On July 15, 2025, a major milestone was marked with the inauguration of the 120-bedded Orthopedic Additional Block at the Government Bone & Joint Hospital, Barzulla, Srinagar by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jammu & Kashmir Shri Omar Abdullah. Funded by the World Bank under JTFRP, the facility includes three operation theatres and a six-bed ICU, significantly enhancing the region's orthopedic care capabilities.

On the following day, July 16, 2025, in Kolkata, Hon'ble MoS (IC) Shri Pratap Rao Jadhav inaugurated the construction of a G+7 RCC-framed boys' hostel at the National Institute of Homeopathy, the 400-capacity hostel spans over 7,800 sqm and will serve UG and PG students in homeopathic medicine.

At the national level, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated two Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) buildings in Bihar, strengthening the state's digital infrastructure and innovation ecosystem.

Institutionally, the month saw the signing of annual MoUs with various NPCC Zonal Managers, reaffirming our collective goals for the year 2025-2026. Additionally, on July 4, 2025, a significant MoU was signed with the North Eastern Regional Institute of Water and Land Management (NERIWALM) for PMC services in administrative infrastructure upgrades.

On July 3, 2025, the Committee of Parliament on Official Language conducted an inspection at NPCC's Madhya Pradesh Regional Office, commending the department's compliance with official language policy.

These milestones underscore NPCC's sustained commitment to nation-building through timely and quality infrastructure delivery. We remain focused on advancing projects that contribute to India's long-term growth and development.

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurates Two STPI buildings in Bihar

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated two major Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) buildings in Bihar, executed with the support of NPCC. These initiatives will strengthen Bihar's IT/ITeS ecosystem and foster innovation, entrepreneurship, and technology-led growth. The Patna project involves the construction of a 1,00,000 sq. ft. built-up space at a cost of ₹53.10 crore, jointly funded by the State Government and MeitY/STPI. The G+6 facility includes an incubation centre, auditorium, administrative chambers, cafeteria, gymnasium, guest rooms, sewage treatment plant, fire safety systems, central AC, and landscaped surroundings. It is designed to enhance incubation capacity and accelerate Bihar's IT/ITeS sector growth.

The Darbhanga project, developed at a cost of ₹10.23 crore, comprises a G+1 building with incubation space, auditorium, administrative chambers, cafeteria, UPS and network operating centres, lifts, central AC, fire safety systems, and CCTV. It will provide startups and IT companies with modern infrastructure, high-speed connectivity, and a supportive environment, advancing the "Make in India" initiative. NPCC is privileged to have contributed to these landmark projects and remains committed to delivering high-quality infrastructure that supports India's digital advancement and inclusive development.

Inauguration of Bone & Joint Hospital, Barzulla, Srinagar, Kashmir.

On 15th July 2025, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jammu & Kashmir Shri Omar Abdullah inaugurated 120 Bedded Orthopedic Additional Block at Government Bone & Joint Hospital, Barzulla, Srinagar, Kashmir in the presence of Shri Surinder Chaudhary, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of J&K, Ms. Sakeena Masood Itoo, Hon'ble Minister of H&ME, J&K, Shri Atal Dulloo, IAS, Chief Secretary, J&K, Dr. Syed Abid Rasheed Shah, IAS, Secretary, H&ME, Shiekh Ahsan Ahmed Pardesi, MLA, Lal Chowk & Prof. (Dr.) Iffat Hassan, Principal/Dean, Govt. Medical College, Srinagar.

This newly built Hospital block funded by World Bank under JTFRP as part of an initiative to enhance medical facilities in the region boasts a capacity of 120 beds, three fully equipped operation theaters and a six-bedded ICU designed to cater to a wide range of orthopedic conditions.

Inauguration of Boys Hostel at National Institute of Homeopathy (NIH), Kolkata.

On 16th July 2025, Shri Pratap Rao Jadhav, Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Ayush and Minister of State, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, inaugurated the newly constructed boys' hostel at National Institute of Homeopathy, Kolkata in gracious presence of Dr Sukanta Majumdar (Hon'ble Minister of State for Education, Ministry of Education and DoNER, Govt. of India), Shri Jyotirmay Singh Mahato (Hon'ble MP, Lok Sabha, Purulia, West Bengal) and Shri Pralay Sharma (Director I/C, NIH, Kolkata).

The said boy's hostel has a capacity to accommodate 400 students pursuing the course of UG/PG in the field of homeopathic medicine. It is a G+7, RCC framed structure, with a total height of 28.5m with a total built-up area of 7881 sqm / 84800 sqft.
