Dear Readers,

I am proud to present the highlights of NPCC for this month, reflecting our continued commitment to strengthening infrastructure across education, healthcare, and institutional growth.

NPCC successfully completed the construction and development of Kendriya Vidyalaya schools at Siddipet and Mancherla in Telangana. Each campus includes a school building, staff quarters (Type 2, 3, and 5), a multipurpose hall, pump room, canteen, guard room, boundary wall, internal roads, sports facilities, and full electrical systems. Both projects have achieved 100% completion. At New Tehri, Uttarakhand, work on a similar Kendriya Vidyalaya project is progressing steadily, with 50% completion recorded.

In the health sector, under the Emergency COVID Response Package (ECRP-II) in Uttar Pradesh, NPCC has constructed additional hospital infrastructure. Phase 1 included 6, 20, 32, and 42-bedded units, while Phase 2 involves 6-bed extensions and 50-bedded field hospitals across multiple districts, enhancing regional healthcare capacity.
